TAKE THE CHANCE, MAKE THE CHANGE, TELL YOUR STORY: AUTHENTIC UNIVERSITIES

Higher education institutions are nowadays expected to fill a wide range of roles: they should not only focus on academic (further) education and training and conduct cutting edge research. Additionally, as part of their so-called "third mission", higher education institutions should facilitate the mutual exchange of ideas as well as knowledge between academia and society and thus, enhance their community impact. There is a growing trend towards individualized lifelong learning paths, including parttime and online study programs, as well as a desire among students to combine academic rigor with practical relevance. While the higher education system as a whole – and not the single university – must meet the sum of societal needs, individual universities on their part have to identify their own strengths and decide how to address specific challenges. In this keynote, we will address why authenticity is key for each university to find its unique role and make a positive impact on society.

Prof. Dr. Frank Ziegele is leading the CHE Centre for Higher Education in Gütersloh and the programs in higher education management at the University of Applied Sciences Osnabrück. With 28 years of experience as a researcher, consultant, trainer, teacher, moderator and change agent in higher education, he knows firsthand we should not only understand how higher education systems work - we also need to improve them.



MINDSET FOR LIFE

Darauf aufbauend werden verschiedene theoretische Ansätze zu Mindsets, die auf nachhaltige Entwicklungen und gesellschaftliches Verantwortungsbewusstsein abzielen, vorgestellt. Währenddessen gibt es viel Raum zum Eintauchen in praktische Übungen und Erfahrungen – generell und mit Blick auf die Lehre.


